Heavy Assessments Major tests and projects
 Light Assessments Quizzes and short projects

4. Practice Assessments Learning activities and worksheets

5. Participation Classroom performance

Teachers follow standard methodologies to determine the correct pacing, instructions, and scoring procedures for each type of assessment, which are clearly communicated to students. The flow of assessment types from practice > light > heavy > final allows students to incrementally practice and acquire knowledge while allowing the teacher to check for acquisition of skills and make adjustments to the learning plan as needed.
